COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Beginning Guzheng(初级古筝)

Guzheng (zither or lap harp) was a very popular instrument during ancient times, as early as the Warring States Period. The zheng has an arched surface and is elongated-trapezoidal with 13 to 21 strings stretched over individually movable bridges. It is a pentatonic instrument. Different techniques of playing the guzheng can create sounds that can evoke the sense of a cascading waterfall, thunder, horses' hooves, and even the scenic countryside. In this class, students will be given an initial and orderly training of the hand function, allowing the child to fully coordinate his hand, eye, brain and other sensory organs.

Debate (辩论课)

At Club Parli ,we develop leaders who excel at collaboration teamwork , creativity and imagination, critical thinking and problem solving, global and cultural awareness, flexibility and adaptability, information and civil literacy, social responsibilities and ethics, written and oral communication.

Instructor: Mr. David Bear, Bear is the nation's best middle school and high school parliamentary debate coach, bar none. In college, Bear and his partner finished 2013 ranked as the best parliamentary debate team in California and the second best in the nation. Math Olympiad Preparation (奥数预备班)

Math Olympiad preparation course helps to develop students' intelligence, promotes mathematical thinking, and improves application of knowledge through math logic training. Students will be introduced to sample questions step by step, from easy to complicated examples. We will focus on cultivating students' mathematics ability, mainly, the ability to calculate, think logically and imagine space. Through training, students will gradually learn to analyze, synthesize, classify, abstract, analogy and other important methods of thinking. Most importantly, students will develop scientific and mathematical habit of thinking, which will be great help to their future learning.

Instructor: Mr. Zhenke Jiang has served as a public school math teacher for more than 20 years in China. As a senior math teacher, he was the math coach for the twelfth "Hua Luo Geng Cup" math tournament and had won first prize during young math teacher problem solving Competition in Guangzhou. Since teaching, Mr. Jiang has been coaching Elementary Math Olympiad and "Hua Luo Geng Cup" math tournament for years, his students had won many prizes including both group and individual awards in Guangzhou.

Math Olympiad & AMC8 (初级奥数、中级奥数和AMC8)

Does your child want a little more excitement and challenge from Mathematics other than his/her school course work? Join us in this class with other kids who have the same interest. This course is designed for 4th to 6th graders who are seeking for some math fun by practicing their "math muscle/brain". We will work through the book "Creative Problem Solving in School Mathematics". The purpose of this course is to develop students' math problem solving strategies and critical thinking. We will do some serious math while having tons of math fun and building endless math friendships.

AMC 8 is a math exam designed for middle schoolers (6-8th graders) to promote the development and enhancement of problem-solving skills. "The examination provides an opportunity to apply the concepts taught at the junior high level to problems which not only range from easy to difficult but also cover a wide range of applications. Many problems are designed to challenge students and to offer problem solving experiences beyond those provided in most junior high school mathematics classes." This course is designed to not only help middle schoolers to prepare and do well in their annual AMC8 test but also, mainly, to stimulate their interest in math thinking and problem solving strategies. We are here to build strong foundations and confidence for students' future math learning so that they will make smooth transition to bigger challenges- their high school AMC10 and AMC12 exams.

Students will work on past AMC8 test questions through this course. The instructor will construct lectures based on students' results to strengthen their knowledge and stimulate their creative and critical thinking. Working/debate with their peers/classmates also helps with their understanding and sparkles their lifelong learning abilities. Expect to have tons of math fun and building endless math friendships while doing some serious math problems.

Instructor: Jie Liu-Dr. Liu is currently a university math professor. She has taught college level math for more than ten years in US. While helping her own kids study math, she started her interest in youth math learning and teaching. For the past couple of years, she volunteered in helping math clubs with her children's elementary school and middle school by teaching math Olympiad, MathCounts and AMC series. She is very passionate about education especially early development of math thinking.
